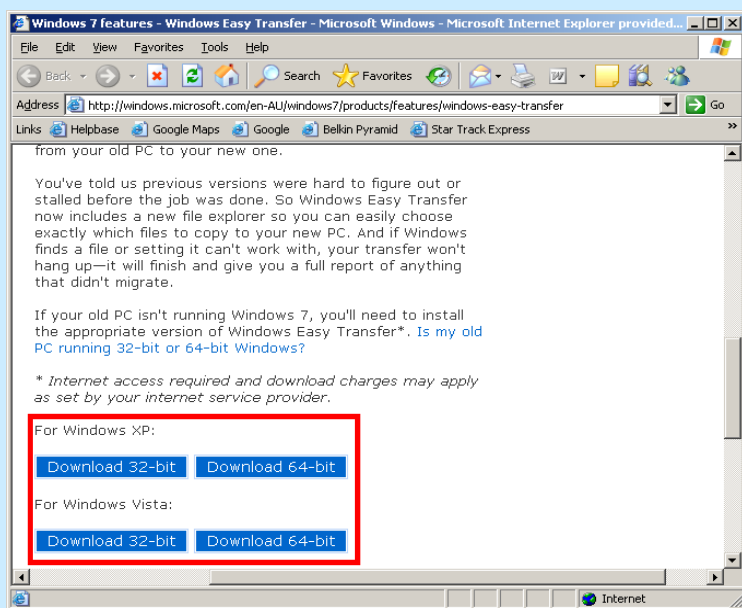




## Easy Transfer Cable - Quick User Guide

Easily migrate your user accounts, music, photo's, documents and more to a new Notebook or PC running Windows 7 using the Windows Vista Transfer Cable—F5U258

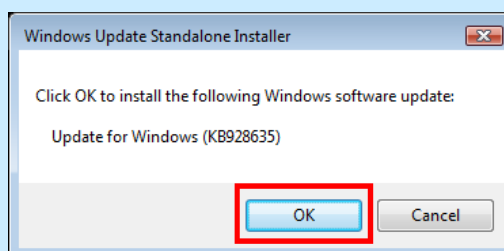


### 1 Prepare your old computer

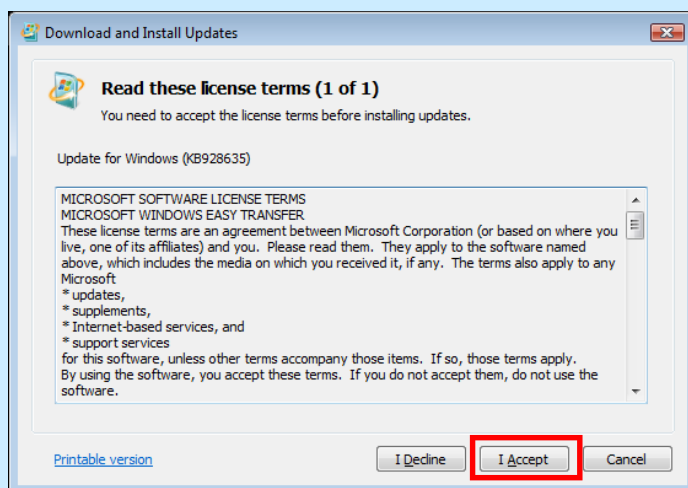
Download and install the Windows 7 easy transfer software onto a computer with Windows XP or Windows Vista:

**Note:** The Windows Easy Transfer Wizard is available in 32- and 64-bit versions, ensure that you install the appropriate version for your operating system.

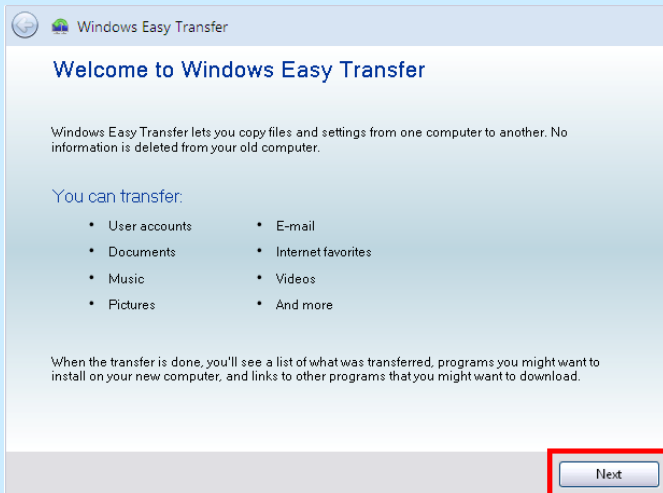
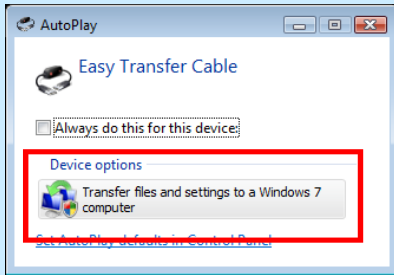


Click on: **OK** to run the easy transfer software update



Click on: **I Accept** to complete the installation

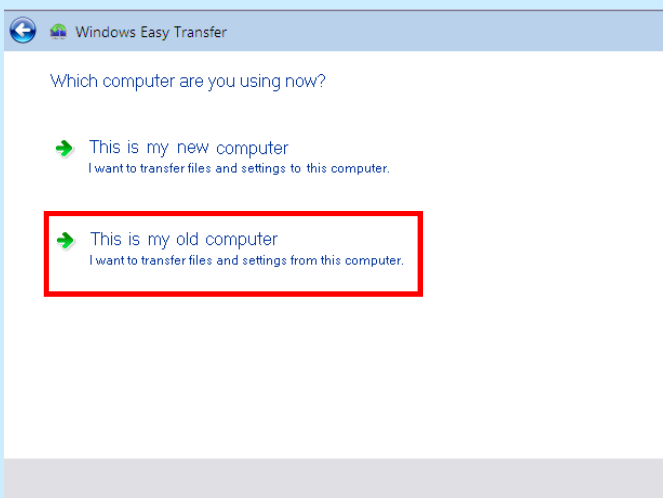
**Note:** If you receive the following error message: The update does not apply to your system; this indicates that the update has already been installed.



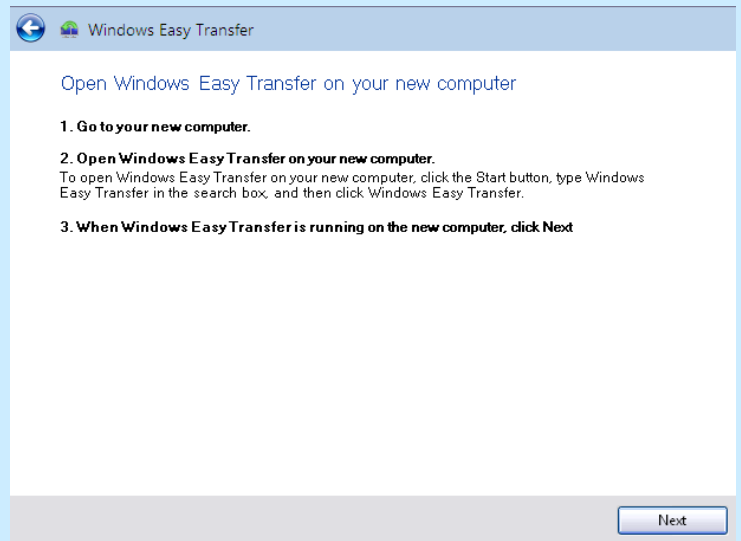
## 2 Setting up the Transfer

Plug one end of the Belkin transfer cable into the old computer running Windows XP or Windows Vista.

Click on: Transfer file and setting to a Windows 7  
Click on: **Next** to begin the transfer process

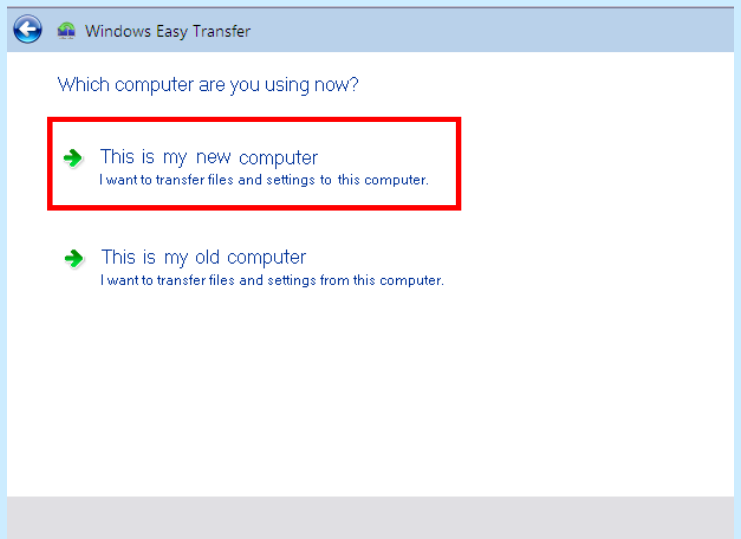


Click on: **This is my old computer**



Plug the other end of the Belkin transfer cable into the new Windows 7 computer.

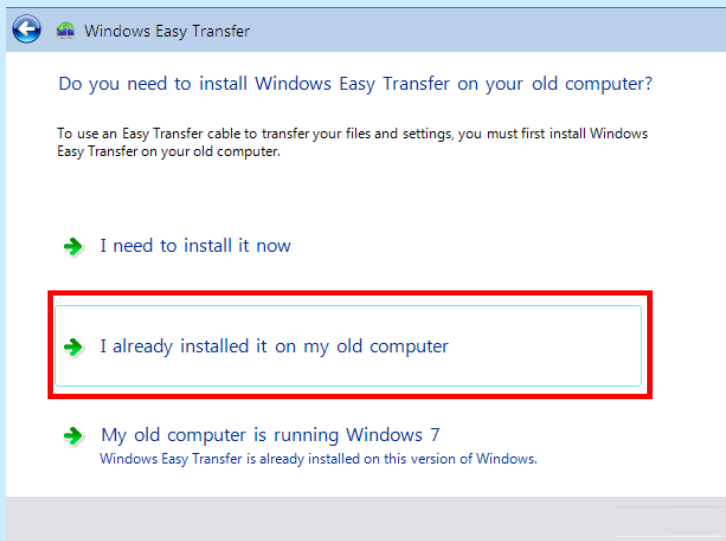
Leave this screen open, **do not** click Next



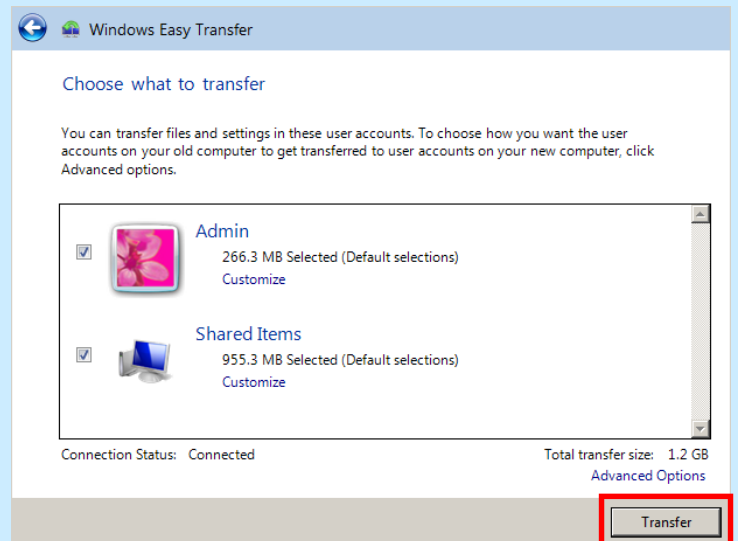
## 3 Run Microsoft Windows Easy Transfer

On your new Windows 7 computer: Click the **Start button**, type **Windows Easy Transfer** in the search box, and then click Windows Easy Transfer

Click on: **This is my new computer**



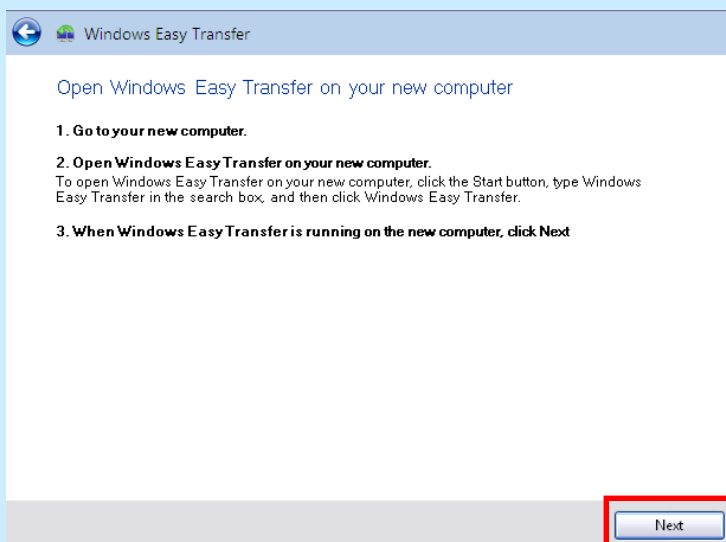
Click on: **I already installed it on my old computer**



## 4 Begin the Transfer

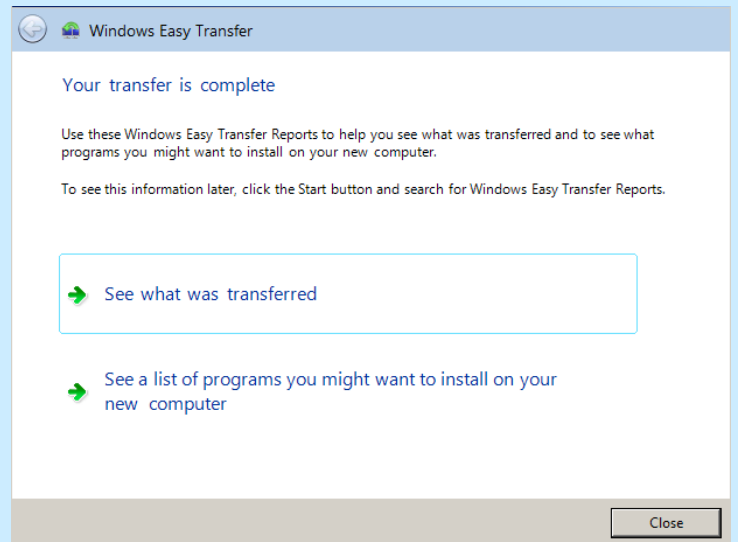
After the connection is established, your old computer will be scanned to determine which files can be transferred.

After the scan is complete, select what components you would like to transfer from your old computer to your new computer and then click **Transfer**



Click on: **Next** on both the old computer (running Windows XP or Vista) and the new Windows 7 computer.

**Note:** The remaining steps will be completed on the Windows 7 computer



Once the transfer is complete, click **Close** to finish.
